

Edgewood College: Visiting Team Information

All intercollegiate contests (except MWW Basketball, Volleyball) utilize off-campus facilities. Therefore pre-game treatments need to be organized in advance. If teams wish to receive treatment prior to their contests, they should plan on arriving on campus 2 hours earlier than a normal arrival at the playing fields. Edgewood College Sports Medicine will make every effort to accommodate your team's medical needs with advanced notice.

Athletic training room access for on-campus athletic events will be defined in our "game protocol" sent to you by email 48 hours in advance of your game at Edgewood College. This protocol is sent to the coach, DA and certified athletic trainer. Access times are divided up for home and visitor use as some teams require a lot of time for pregame treatments and taping and everyone should be giving equal time to prepare the student-athletes for competition. If the time allowed is not adequate to prepare all of your student-athletes, then please consider sending a certified or student-athletic trainer to assist in their pregame preparation.

Water, cups, injury ice, ice bags, and biohazard supplies will be supplied for your team. Please send any additional supplies that your team may require.

A Certified Athletic Trainer will be present for all home contests with the exception of some women's tennis matches and all men's and women's golf outings. If your team will be traveling without a Certified Athletic Trainer and requires special services, please notify Edgewood College Sports Medicine at 608-663-3326 or bhoefer@edgewood.edu in advance so that we may accommodate your team's needs. Please provide a treatment request signed by the Head Athletic Trainer for any treatments requiring therapeutic modalities.
